These include, without limitation, collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders, sponsors, promoters, or drivers, and dangers arising from falls, camping, theft, road surface, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, weather conditions, as well as the possibility of physical and/or mental trauma, mental injury, emotional stress, serious bodily injury resulting in disability, death and paralysis.

I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the activity. I hereby consent to and permit emergency treatment in the event of injury, illness or death.

I give full permission for use of my name and photograph, motion pictures, video tape, recording, written comments or opinions, or other records of this event for any legitimate purpose. Pedal Across Wisconsin, Inc. reserves the right to decline accepting or retaining any tour participant whose health or actions impede the operation of the tour, or welfare of other tour participants. An approved (ANSI or Snell or equal) helmet is strongly recommended for use by all participants while riding bicycles.
